Other Fundraising

Even though regular fundraising for the school year will be over after the Eileen's Colossal Cookie Dough and Cherry Berry, you can always participate in our three on-going fundraisers:

- 1) **Hy-Vee cards** - The form is attached to the newsletter. Hy-Vee cards are sold at Band Booster meetings, band concerts and other events.
- 2) **Interstate Batteries** - We have packs of 24 – AA & AAA batteries available. The packs sell for \$15 each and the students receive a profit of \$9-\$10 on each pack sold. The battery form is available online and batteries are sold at Band Booster meetings, Band concerts and other events.
- 3) **Scrip Cards** –WHS Band Boosters will order gift cards at a discount; families pay face value for the cards and the difference is an instant rebate for your students account.
